ADDISON COUNTY

RED CLOVER FAMILY DENTISTRY

Offers basic and restorative dental care (including dentures) and simple extractions. Open to all Vermont residents, please call to check if they're accepting new patients. For uninsured patients with income under 200% FPL, there is a sliding scale. Accepts Medicaid.

OPEN DOOR CLINIC

100 Porter Drive, Middlebury, VT 388-0137

Offers free basic and restorative dental care and simple extractions for under-insured people whose health insurance deductible exceeds 10% of their gross income. Income must be under 300% FPL.

Does not accept Medicaid or Medicare.

BENNINGTON COUNTY

BATTENKILL VALLEY HEALTH CENTER

Offers basic and restorative dental care. Open to all Vermont residents. For uninsured or under-insured patients, there is a sliding scale up to 200% FPL. Accepts Medicaid. Call to see if accepting new patients.

WINDSOR COUNTY

RED LOGAN/GOOD NEIGHBOR DENTAL CLINIC

70 North Main Street, White River Jct., VT 295-7573

Offers free basic and restorative dental care to uninsured adults who live within 20 miles of White River Junction and have income under 200% FPL. Application available on website:

Definitions: A sliding scale means that the amount of the fee will depend on your income. You can find the latest Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines online. Basic dental care may include checkups, cleanings, sealants, and X-rays. Restorative dental care may include fillings, crowns, bridges, implants, and dentures. An extraction is when a tooth is removed in its entirety. Vermonters experiencing homelessness may qualify for free dental care at the Community Health Centers of Burlington (limit: \$1,000/year).

EMERGENCY DENTAL ASSISTANCE:

After contacting a dentist and making an appointment, you can apply in person for a general assistance voucher at your local Community Action Agency (or at your Economic Services Division District Office.)

Vouchers are available to help offset some of the cost for emergency dental extractions. People with dental emergencies such as pain, bleeding or infection may be eligible for these vouchers. Contact the local Economic Services Division District Office at 1-800-479-6151 to determine eligibility and what is and is not covered.

HEALTH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM 847-6984

This program, funded through the UVM Medical Center, the Vermont Coalition of Clinics for the Uninsured and the State of Vermont, provides financial assistance with obtaining ongoing health care, including dental care and dentures, for Vermonters with income up to 400% of the federal poverty level. Call 847-6984 to find out if you are eligible.
